Central Health wishes to advise the public that mass immunization clinics are open to the general public and new clinics have been scheduled on Monday, November 23 and Tuesday, November 24.

These clinics are also open to children requiring a second pediatric dose of the H1N1 vaccine. It is critical that children not present for the second pediatric dose of vaccine unless they meet the following criteria.

- All children ages six months up to but not including three years of age;
- Children ages three up to but not including 10 who have a **chronic illness**; and
- Children must have received their first pediatric dose a **minimum of 21 days** before receiving the second pediatric dose (parents are asked to bring documentation of the dates of their first immunization).

As more vaccine arrives, additional mass immunization clinics will be scheduled. This information will be posted to Central Health's website ([www.centralhealth.nl.ca](http://www.centralhealth.nl.ca)).

Please be advised, as per previous announcements, in the central region **high school students will be immunized in school on Monday, November 23 and Tuesday, November 24** as per arrangements made by the Nova Central School District.

Members of the public are reminded that they need to bring their MCP card with them to register at mass immunization clinics. Also, children must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian who can sign a legal consent form for them to receive the H1N1 vaccine.
