PHYSICAL CHANGES of PUBERTY



Taller, bigger & stronger



Penis & testicles will get bigger



Voice gets deeper



Hair on face, pubic area, and other body areas

WHAT'S UP DOWN THERE?

Why is my penis getting hard?

- Ⓞ This is called an erection
- Ⓞ Erections are when blood vessels in your penis fill with blood
- Ⓞ This can happen even without thinking about sexual things
- Ⓞ Don't worry, unwanted erections are normal, and usually stop as you get older!



I wake up with sticky underwear, why?

- Ⓞ This is called a "wet dream", or a nocturnal emission
- Ⓞ Wet dreams happen when you ejaculate in your sleep
- Ⓞ This happens during puberty, and you will grow out of it as you get older

Does penis size matter?

- Ⓞ No! Not at all. Penises do vary in length and shape, but not as much as you may think.

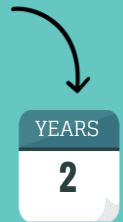


Girls mature

Healthy Eating

Your body needs fuel! Eat lots of fruit, veggies, eggs, meat, whole grain bread and cereals.



Get lots of sleep

When you go through puberty, your body needs lots of rest. About 8-9 hours a night.



Be Active

You can go for a bike ride, dance to your favourite song, whatever gets you moving & having fun!
