TRANSPORTATION OF DANGEROUS GOODS

According to Canada's Transportation of Dangerous Goods (TDG) General Policy Advisory Council, all individuals who transport, offer or sell dangerous goods must be certified or may otherwise be subject to fines and/or suspension. This safety course in TDG is an affordable solution designed to help you comply with current regulations in any Canadian province and territory. For vendors who this certification applies to, we request that you complete this training as it will be mandatory in our RHAs.
