The Baby-Friendly Hospital Initiative (BFHI) was launched by the World Health Organization (WHO) and UNICEF in 1991 and is an evidence based international initiative to protect, promote and support breastfeeding. Breastfeeding is an important, globally recognized indicator of maternal child health. While most Canadian families initiate breastfeeding (90%), many stop within the first weeks or month, and only a third meet the global target of breastfeeding exclusively to six months.

The Breastfeeding Committee for Canada is leading a Quality Improvement Collaborative that will scale up the implementation of the Baby-Friendly Initiative in Canada. Twenty-five participating hospitals across Canada will be assisted on their journey to become a Baby-Friendly designated hospital. Central Health is pleased to be one of those organizations.

The Baby Friendly Initiative Team has been developed to guide the implementation of the Baby Friendly Initiative (BFI) within Central Health. The team is seeking an individual with lived experience as an integral team member. The Patient Experience Advisor would have had experience with infant feeding / breastfeeding and an interest it the Baby Friendly Initiative process.
